OBSERVATIONS

Findings or other clinical data collected about a patient during care.

DATA ELEMENT	APPLICABLE VOCABULARY STANDARD(S)
<p>Advance Directive Observation</p> <p>Statement of presence and properties of patient or provider authored documents that record a patient's goals, preferences and priorities should a patient be unable to communicate them to a provider.</p> <p>Usage note: May include whether a person has one or more advance directives, the type of advance directive, the location of the current source document, and whether it has been verified.</p> <p>Examples include but are not limited to indication that a living will is on file, reference to or location of durable medical power of attorney, and validating provider.</p>	

ORDERS

Provider-authored directive for the delivery of patient care services.

DATA ELEMENT	APPLICABLE VOCABULARY STANDARD(S)
<p>Orders</p> <p>Provider-authored directive for the delivery of patient care services.</p> <p>Examples include but are not limited to diagnostic imaging, laboratory tests, interventions, referrals and consultations, and do-not-resuscitate.</p>	

USCDI Draft v5 Discussion

February 27, 2024 Discussion

Evolution of ADI Data Exchange & USCDI

- Initial work revealed sections of the CDA/FHIR document that were important to “bundle” in the FHIR document to ensure context of the concepts was preserved
- In addition to creating guidance to move from paper forms to interoperable electronic access across systems, we needed to accommodate not only structured ADI but also support the need to liberate existing scanned forms from clinical record systems
- Person-authored data needs to be accommodated in our clinical record systems to inform treatment
- The following graphic shows the maturation of understanding that was enabled through stakeholder involvement and numerous testing events

We understand that Data Class is merely an organizing concept

- **Healthcare Agent NOT Durable Medical Power of Attorney (L1):** Who is designated to speak for me if I am unable to do so myself?
- **Care Experience Preference & Treatment Intervention Preference:** What is important for providers to know about my goals, preferences, and priorities for care as I receive care?
- **Advance Directive (L2) & Personal Advance Care Plan (L1):** For scanned or unstructured documents that reside in systems, a data element that enables them to be made available for data exchange and access
- **Advance Directive Observation:** AD/ACP documents are not immediately actionable in most healthcare settings
- **Portable Medical Order (L2):** Portable Medical Orders are actual Practitioner-Authored orders or order sets (form-dependent)
- **Care Team Members – Proxy Decision Maker (L0):** The term shown should be able to be more over-arching as a concept, and is not always an active member of the Care Team
