Testing Components: Health IT developer self-declaration to the testing outcomes

Test Procedure Version 1.1 – Last Updated 09/21/17

Note: The order in which the test steps are listed reflects the sequence of the certification criterion and does not necessarily prescribe the order in which the test should take place.

Required Tests

(d)(5)Automatic access time-out.

(i) Automatically stop user access to health information after a predetermined period of inactivity.

Standard(s): None

Criteria ¶	System Under Test	Test Lab Verification
(i)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The user logs in and waits the defined amount of time for a period of inactivity. After the defined period of inactivity, the user cannot access health information. 	The tester verifies that a user cannot gain further access to the health information after the period of inactivity expires.

(ii) Require user authentication in order to resume or regain the access that was stopped.

Standard(s): None

Criteria ¶	System Under Test	Test Lab Verification
(ii)	A user is forced to authenticate their credentials before regaining access.	The tester verifies that a user must re-enter credentials in order to access health information within the Health IT Module after the access has been stopped.
