

## 2024-30 Fed HIT Strategic Plan Public Comment

On slide #6 entitled Fed HIT Principles, it says “Data-led decision-making.”

As a clinician and provider system executive, I **strongly oppose** the idea of “data-led decision making.”

Decision making should be “Person-centered” (data can inform decision making, but it should not be “data-led”).

“Data-led” is problematic on many levels including...

- “Data-led” puts data above people;
- HIT data are incomplete, even the best systems;
- HIT-derived data quality are generally low; and
- Data are only helpful when properly contextualized in ethical and personalized (person-centered) decision making.

I recommend changing this item to: “**Person-centered decision making.**”
