


AIRA's Measurement and Improvement Initiative (M&I)

M&I began in 2015 in collaboration with CDC as an effort to:

- Test IIS alignment with standards
- Provide IIS with info and assistance to improve


All testing is conducted by AIRA through:

- Connecting with pre-production systems and/or analyzing deidentified data
- Sharing results via the Aggregate Analysis Reporting Tool (AART)



Great Engagement In Voluntary Measurement


- Community-wide participation is strong and increasing
- Improvements in standardization across IIS are broadly recognized



AART User Interface



- All results from Measurement and Improvement are available to IIS and Immunization Programs to review and share within the AART application
- At Validation stage, results become available to the general public










Immunization Integration Program (IIP) Goals & Strategies


IIP is a collaboration between AIRA, CDC, and HIMSS to improve interoperability between health IT and IIS

- Strategies:
 - Testing & Recognition Initiative an alternative to ONC F1 testing where EHRs demonstrate and can be tested and recognized for immunization capabilities
 - **Collaborative** diverse forum to develop interoperability recommendations and solutions for improved immunization interoperability


